A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER/TREASURER OF THE CITY OF ROSSTON, ARKANSAS SYSTEM TO EXECUTE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE <u>DRINKING WATER SRF</u> LOAN PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE ARKANSAS NATURAL RESOURCES COMMISSION

- WHEREAS, the City of Rosston, Arkansas owns and operates a water system (the "System") in order to provide water service to meet the needs of the City and its inhabitants; and
- WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its inhabitants to apply for loan assistance from the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission (the "ANRC") under the Drinking Water SRF Program (the "Program"), in order to make certain improvements to the System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Rosston, Arkansas:

- Section 1. That the Mayor of the City, as a Signatory Agent or the successor of said Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to make application for assistance under the Program administered by the ANRC and to execute, when approved by the City Council, a bond purchase agreement and instruments issued or made pursuant thereto on behalf of the City from time to time.
- Section 2. That the Recorder/Treasurer of the System, as a Signatory Agent or the successor of said Agent, is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, all other documents and certificates required by the department for participation in the Program.

- 1. That the City hereby concurs with the proposed recommended facilities in the Environmental Information Document and Facilities Plan and authorizes their submittal to the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
- That the City intends to construct, operate and maintain such facilities in accordance with State and Federal requirements if said facilities are approved and funded by the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

RESOLUTION NO. 1-2/

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT REGARDING THE <u>WATER</u> SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

- WHEREAS, the City of <u>Rosston</u>, Arkansas (the "City") proposes to acquire, construct and equip improvements to the City's water system (the "Project"), described as follows: Water System Improvements including Tank and Meter Improvements.
- WHEREAS, the estimated costs of the Project and paying expenses are \$545,652; and
- WHEREAS, the City does not have funds on hand to pay the costs of the Project and expenses; and
- WHEREAS, the City proposes to obtain funds to accomplish the Project and to pay expenses from tax-exempt bonds issued by the City and sold through an underwriter or to a bank or a governmental entity (the "City Bonds"); and
- WHEREAS, the principal amount of the City Bonds allocated to the Project and expenses will not exceed \$ 545,652; and
- WHEREAS, the proceeds of the City Bonds will be made available to the City through the issuance by the City and sale to one or more of the entities listed above of an evidence of indebtedness of the City in the form of a bond;
- WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution is for the City to declare its "official intent" for the issuance of the City Bonds within the meaning of United States Treasury Regulation §1.150-2;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Rosston, Arkansas:

Section 1: That the City hereby expresses its intent to advance its own funds to pay the costs of the Project and expenses and to reimburse itself from the proceeds of the City Bonds.

Section 2: That a copy of the Resolution with original signatures shall be furnished by the Mayor to the Funding Entity.
